

STANDING ORDER NO. 01 / 2002

It has been observed that Orderly Rooms are not being held regularly in the Districts as envisaged under Police Rules 14.10, whereby it is mandatory for the District Superintendents of Police to hold an Orderly Room once a week. Orderly Room does give an insight to the officers into problems faced by the constabulary. It establishes a direct communication between officers and men and helps to remove the barriers of intermediary staff at the level of supervisory, ministerial and line staff. It also curtails the time element which delays the disposal of these problems, paving way for the complaints and suggestions to be discussed and disposed of directly and openly.

It is, therefore, ordered that henceforth the district SsP shall regularly hold orderly rooms to institutionalize this most important forum of man-management, followed by quarterly Darbars held by the D.IsG Ranges/Regions and returns submitted to the CPO by 10th of each month, to reflect on the regimental cognizance taken in each district/region.

Any non-compliance or disregard of the aforesaid orders shall be viewed seriously.
