

STANDING ORDER NO. 05 / 2004

IMPLEMENTATION OF ARTICLE - 34 OF POLICE ORDER 2002

1. OBJECT:

The Police Order has since been promulgated and Article-34 of the Order 2002 enshrines that Police assistance to any functionary of the Federal Government, Provincial Government, any statutory body or any body or corporation owned, setup or controlled by any such Government or which such Government has a controlling share or interest, District Government, Tehsil or Town Municipal Administration or Union Administration, or Cantonment Board may for the discharge of its official duties which in his opinion **require Police assistance, ask for the Police support from the concerned Police authority and such authority shall provide the requisite support.**

2. PURPOSE:

In order to ensure implementation of the various aspects of Article- 34 above, and to evolve a system of monitoring, evaluation and reporting of Police response the following Standing Operation Procedure may be adopted.

3. PROCEDURE:

- (i) Whenever a Police Officer/SHO receives a requisition for help /himself becomes acquainted with such a need, he shall immediately proceed or dispatch a party to provide needed Assistance till the finalization of the issue at hand and make a report in DD of all such requisition by any functionary of the Federal Government, Provincial Government, any statutory body or any body or corporation owned, setup or controlled by any such Government or in which such Government has a controlling share or interest, District Government, Tehsil or Town Municipal Administration or Union Administration, or Cantonment Board may for the discharge of his official duties and immediately dispatch a copy to DPO /Superintendent of Police Investigation.
- (ii) That if the concerned SHO/Police Officer is not in a position to extend such assistance, he should immediately bring the matter in to the notice of DPO, who will in turn manage for the provision of such assistance/support and in case the DPO cannot extend such support, he will inform the District Nazim on this score.
- (iii) However, before informing the competent authority all the subordinate officers shall make hectic efforts to extend full assistance.
- (iv) Where ever the Police Officer considers that the requisition seeking Police Assistance is unnecessary, illegal or based on malafide, he will inform the DPO through his senior Officer and the DPO will approach the Public Safety Commission and under such a situation the decision of Public Safety

- Commission shall prevail.
- (v) If the District Nazim so directs, the DPO will be responsible to provide Police assistance for maintenance of Law & Order, natural calamities and emergencies concerning District Government, Tehsil Administration or Union Council Administration.
 - (vi) In case any authority issues illegal order based on malafide, the DPO will approach Public Safety Commission and its decision shall be final.

4. COMPILATION & EVALUATION OF REPORTS:

The District Police Officers shall compile a monthly return of all assistance provided vide 1,2,3 above and submit it to the DIG Investigation, CPO on proforma (attached) already circulated by 5th of each month. All the Subordinate Officers are therefore, directed to adhere the directions enshrined in Article-34 of Police Order 2002, to ensure implementation of its contents.
